





## SUSTAINING INCLUSION RESEARCH


- Grants awarded in six rounds 2013 to 2019
- Grants ranged from 7 months to 30 months
- Research on former grantees conducted 2020
- 38 former grantees eligible for survey
- 68.4% of former grantees responded (n=26)
- Responses self-reported, not verified
- Primary research question: Did inclusion continue after grant funding ceased?

## INCLUSIVE PLANNING SUSTAINED



A follow-up report showed that 90% of grantees continued inclusive transportation planning after their Transit Planning 4 All project funding ended.


# POST-GRANT INCLUSION



Former grantees worked within their communities to continue to promote inclusion.









## HOW TO SUSTAIN INCLUSION
