## **Project Objective**

The objective of the Mountain Line Microtransit Pilot is to fill the transportation gap in the Huntington and Industrial Drive area by utilizing on-demand microtransit technology, coordinating with the Mountain Line paratransit program, connecting people to the broader transit system, and ensuring the program is accessible, equitable, inclusive, and usable by the diverse populations in Flagstaff.



### **Outcomes**

- Number of trips per vehicle increases
- Fixed-route ridership on near-by stops increases
- Reduced travel time from Downtown Connection Center to corridor
- Number of trips to agencies in the corridor increases in ridership during the pilot

  - Robo call and sent letters to paratransit clients
  - Worked with partners

  - 2 surveys
  - 3 outreach events
- Begin program design
  - Goals and priorities exercise
